

Academic Audit Report 2020-21

IQAC takes measures to review and improve the teaching learning process through a well-structured academic audit, with an aim to inherit checks and balances for sensitizing quality of academic standards, for the wholesome development of students of all undergraduate, postgraduate and research programmes. Under academic audit, each department conducts a self-audit on course files and submits the compliance report to IQAC at the end of each semester. The course files contain all the necessary details of the teaching-learning process. During the audit process in the academic year 2020-21, the components of the course files such as course content, entry behaviour test, work plan and modes of continuous assessments were audited. The departments had adopted various continuous assessment modes which included case writing, creation of videos, presentations, seminars, short research projects, working models and open book exams. The Rubrics followed for the assessments of lab courses, seminars and assignments were also audited. The students were able to view the continuous assessment marks in their portal soon after the course teachers made an online entry of the marks in the faculty portal. The compliance certificates were signed by the respective Heads of departments and submitted to the IQAC office.
